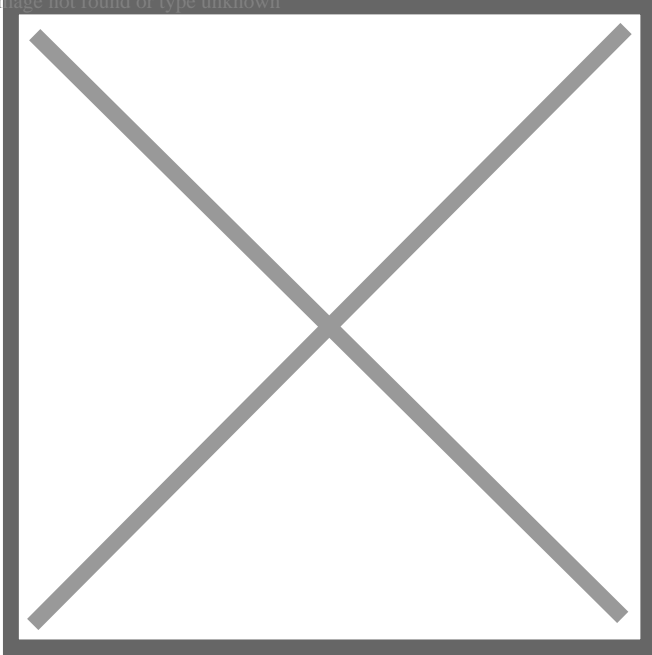


Setting a Static IP - MacOS

1. Click on the **Apple logo** in the top right and select **System Preferences**

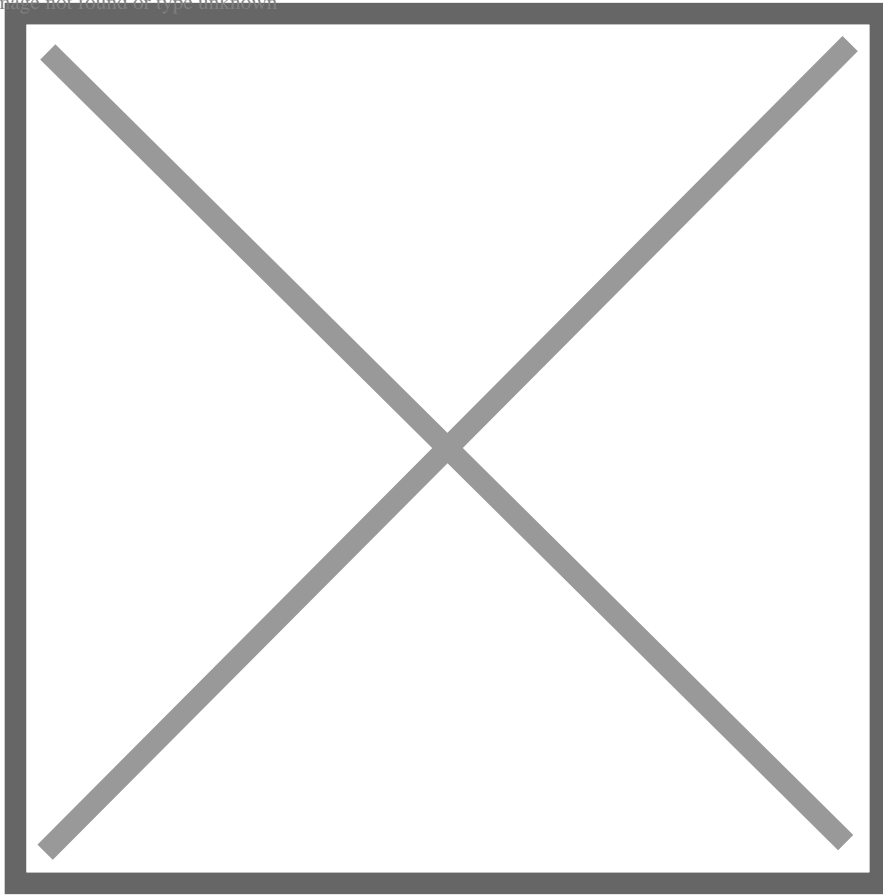

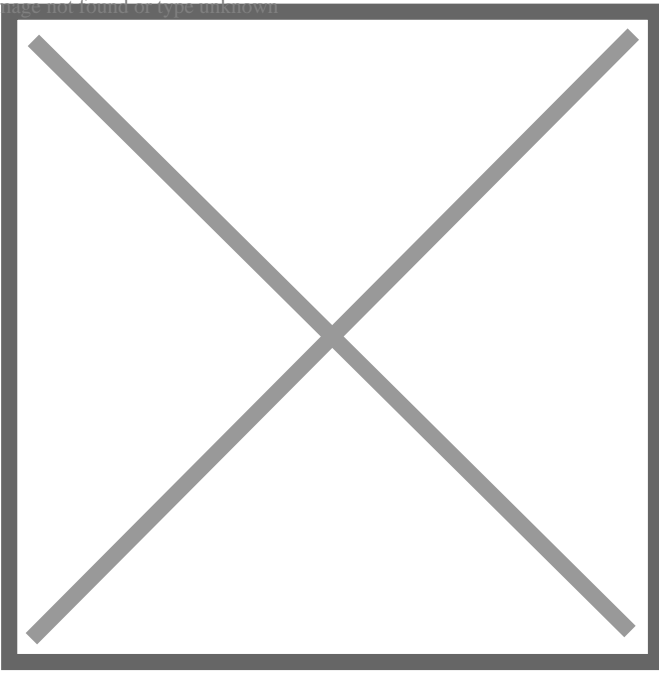

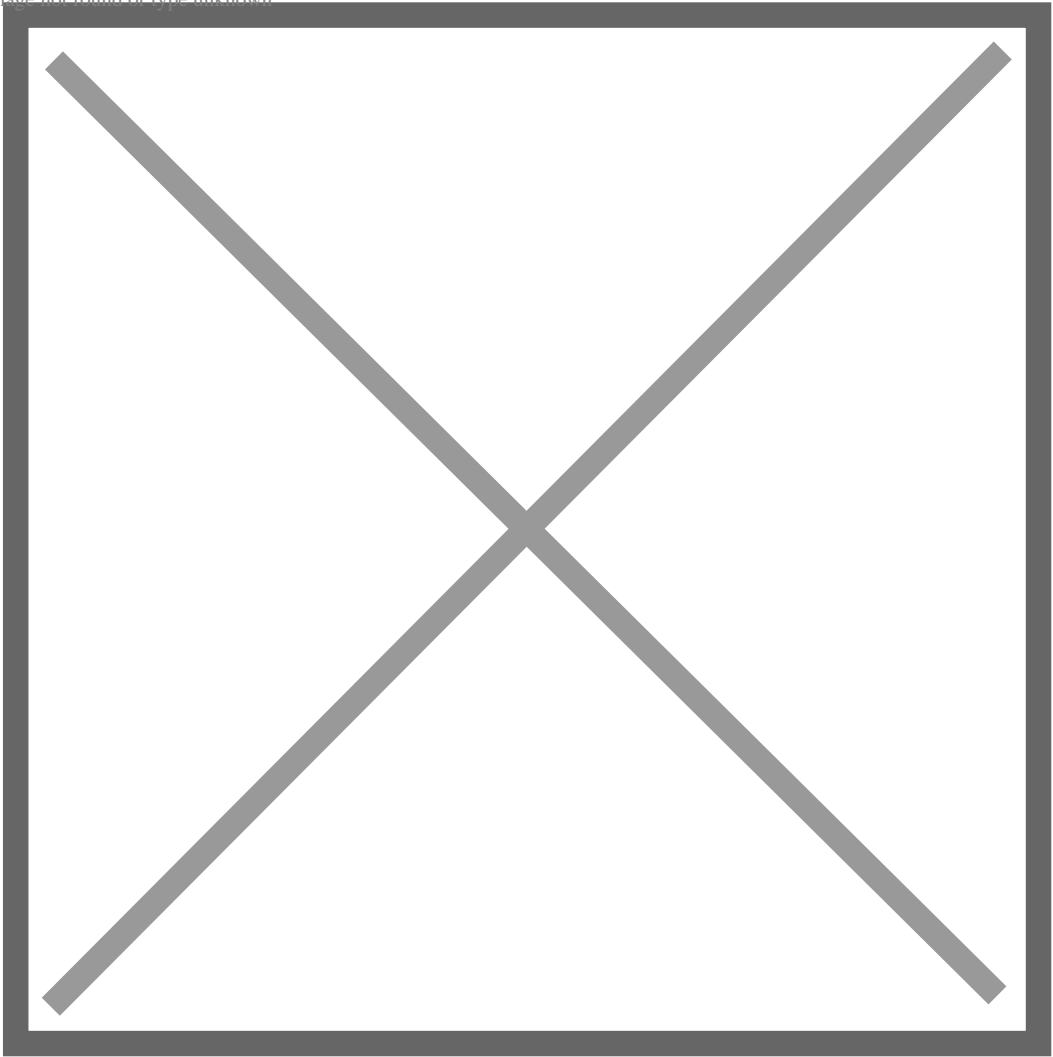
