Step-by-Step: Reset Your Password

1. Go to the Password Reset Portal

2. Enter Your Work Email

Type in your full Microsoft 365 email address, like:

jdoe@yourcompany.com

Enter the characters from the image (CAPTCHA), then click **Next**

3. Choose a Verification Method

You'll see the recovery options you set up earlier:

- Text message
- Phone call
- Authenticator app
- Alternate email

If you don't see any options, you haven't registered yet. Contact IT for help.

4. Enter the Verification Code

Microsoft will send you a code via the method you chose.

5. Create a New Password

You'll be asked to enter and confirm a **new password**.

Make sure your new password:

- Is at least 8 characters long
- Includes letters and numbers
- Is different from your old passwords
